Application of this skill set is appropriate only when assessment of the client's feet by a relevant health professional has identified basic foot skin and nail care services as appropriate. Students will be existing workers in industry. Final assessment and observation will be in the workplace.

Chronic Disease Self-Management Skill Set

Statement of Attainment, includes 2 units of competency:

- CHCCCS001 Address the needs of people with chronic disease
- CHCCCS023 Support independence and wellbeing



This skill set has been endorsed by industry as appropriate for people who hold a community services or health qualification at Certificate IV level or higher or commensurate industry skills as evaluated through recognition of prior learning processes. It provides a set of skills required to assist clients with self-management of chronic disease. Final assessment and observation will be in the workplace. Students will be existing workers in industry.

Final assessment and observation will be in the workplace (multiple occasions, medications, residents). Students will be existing workers in industry.

Final assessment and observation will be in the workplace. Students will be existing workers in industry.

Final assessment and observation will be in the workplace. Students will be existing workers in industry.

Final assessment and observation will be in the workplace (multiple occasions, medications, residents). Students will be existing workers in industry.

These units provide credit towards a range of qualifications in the CHC Community Services Training Package at Certificate IV and Diploma level. Final assessment and observation will be in the workplace. Students will be existing workers in industry.

Suitable for those working in a care or support role in the community services industry and wish to develop skills in supporting people requiring palliative care, this skill set provides training in grief and loss support and delivering care services using a palliative approach. Final assessment and observation will be in the workplace. Students will be existing workers in industry.

Final assessment and observation will be in the workplace. Students will be existing workers in industry.

Allied Health Assistance - Community Rehabilitation Skill Set

Statement of Attainment, includes 2 units of competency:

This skill set has been endorsed by industry as suitable for individuals working in the health industry who wish to develop skills in community rehabilitation assistance. These units provide credit towards a range of qualifications in the HLT Health Training Package, including HLT43015 Certificate IV in Allied Health Assistance. Final assessment and observation will be in the workplace. Students will be existing workers in industry.

This nursing course is your chance to start a career working in one of our most vital industries. A graduate from a Diploma of Nursing program, approved by the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia (NMBA), is able to apply for registration with AHPRA as an enrolled nurse. The course is also appropriate for those who have been working as an AIN/PCA/HAS and wish to move to the next level. If you are looking for a change in career or are looking to start your career in Nursing, this is the course for you! The Diploma of Nursing assumes no prior knowledge of Nursing, so NO nursing background is required. South Coast Careers College implements a variety of methods to meet individual learning needs. Blended learning is a key component that includes a combination of face-to-face, virtual, online, self-directed, text and workplace-based learning opportunities.
