



SITHFAB021 Provide Responsible Service of Alcohol

Course Overview

To sell, serve or supply alcohol in NSW, you must complete an RSA training course provided by an approved training provider. If you are new to the liquor industry or your RSA competency training took place more than five years ago, you need to complete a full training course.

Benefits

You will be able to engage confidently in the service of alcohol when you understand and apply the principles and rules of responsible service. When alcohol is served responsibly the workplace is safe and the venue is more attractive to a variety of patrons.

Learning Outcomes

The RSA course includes the following:

- NSW liquor laws and selling, serving, or supplying alcohol responsibly
- Intoxication, including assisting customers to drink within appropriate limits, assessing alcohol affected customers and refusing service
- Minors, including ID checks and secondary sale/supply
- Harm minimisation strategies
- Compliance and enforcement

Career Opportunities

- Bar work and roles including service of alcohol in hotels, clubs and restaurants
- Delivery driver for stores which sell and deliver alcohol to homes and businesses



Entry Requirements

Entry requirements into SITHFAB002:

- Must be at least 17 years of age
- Must attend full day of training

To access any available funding, you must be:

- no longer at school;
- an Australian citizen, Australian permanent resident, Australian humanitarian visa holder or New Zealand citizen;
- living or working in NSW;

Course Duration

This course is a one (1) day from 9 am to 4.30 pm.

Assessment

Assessment delivered via work booklets and practical assessment which include demonstrating skills in a classroom environment.
