Tech Savvy Seniors is a NON-ACCREDITED course that delivers low-cost digital literacy training to seniors so they can develop the skills and confidence to access information and services online. The program provides training in computers, tablets, and smart phones to help seniors to stay connected with their families, friends and communities. It delivers real health, social and community benefits, especially for those in rural and remote areas.

Tech Savvy Seniors NSW is a partnership between the NSW Government and Telstra. It is a key initiative of the NSW Ageing Strategy. The partnership helps bridge the gap between those seniors who use technology and those who don't.

Target Audience

The course is designed for all individuals interested in learning how to develop their skills and confidence with computers, smart phones, and tablets.

Benefits

This program was designed to support older people get connected, and participate in the ever-increasing online world, with the real objective of increasing digital inclusion amongst the ageing, and helping reduce social isolation

Course Duration

This course runs every Thursday 9 am to 11 am for 9 weeks. You can do 9 weeks or select to attend according to your level of expertise and the level of support and learning you need.

Beginners:	Weeks 1- 4	Introduction to the internet, email, smart phones, online shopping, social media, tablets / iPad
Intermediate:	Weeks 5 - 8	Introduction to the internet, email Part 2 and 3, NSW Seniors' Card, NSW Transport apps, social media, sharing photos and other attachments.
Advanced:	Week 9	Introduction to online shopping and banking, introduction to social media and video calling

Entry Requirements

- Must be at least 60 years of age, (Indigenous at least 50 years).
- Have your own device which could be a computer, tablet or mobile phone is preferred however student laptops are available for loan in class times as required.
